

How to setup a new Google account on your Android phone

Your StandUp Wireless Android device has Google account setup available within the Settings menu. Instructions for the process are detailed below:

1. Open the Settings app.
 - b. Access the device dashboard by swiping downward from the top of the screen.
 - c. Tap the **gear icon**.
2. Scroll down and tap **Users & accounts**.
3. Tap **Add Account**.
4. Tap **Google**.
5. Tap **Create account**.
 - a. If you already have a Google account, feel free to sign in with your existing credentials.
 - b. Continue to the next step to continue setting up a new account.
6. Type in the name associated with the account.
 - a. Using your real name is recommended.
7. Tap **Next**.
8. Enter the birthdate associated with the account.
9. Select a gender. If you do not wish to be identified by your gender, you can select decline to state.
10. Tap **Next**.
11. Select one of the suggested usernames or create a different one. If you are creating a different address, type in your username.
 - a. This username will become your Gmail address as well as how you log into your account.
 - b. If your desired username is taken, you'll be told to pick another and given suggestions.
12. Tap **Next**.
13. Type in a new password for your account. The password has to be at least eight characters. No numbers or special characters are required.
 - a. Re-type your new password in the Confirm password box. You'll be told how strong or weak the password you've selected is.
14. Tap **Next**.
15. You'll be asked if you want to add a phone number. This phone number can be used to verify your identity, help log into your account and help people find you if they have your phone number.
 - a. Tap Yes, I'm in to add your number or Skip to forgo it.
16. Google will present their terms of use. After scrolling through and reading the sections that interest you, tap **I agree**.
17. Your core Google Account is now set up, and your username and the length of your password will be shown. Tap Next to exit this screen.
